This is the letter you requested regarding your son, Yitzchok Meir (D.O.B 7/29/91). I have formally evaluated Yitzchok and have found him suffering from Conduct Disorder, L.D., n.o.s., and R/O Mood Disorder, n.o.s.

Yitzchok has a longstanding history of manipulative and aggressive behavior. He reportedly terrorizes his younger siblings and has been physically aggressive to parents and siblings. Attempts at treatment have failed both in Israel and in the United States. Yitzchok is currently hospitalized at Hillside Hospital, on an inpatient psychiatric unit. It is my recommendation that this young man be placed in a residential treatment center, directly after being discharged from the hospital. This young man poses a danger to himself and his family and should not be returned home awaiting placement.

I understand that you will be showing this letter to the treatment team at the hospital and also in applying for entitlements.
